



**Call for Volunteers

Waterfront Neighbourhood Centre (WNC) is now recruiting WNC members and volunteers to participate on our Board committees and as possible Board Members.

With an annual budget of \$3.33 Million and an annual staff complement of 80-90, our 44,950 sq. ft. community centre provides a wide range of programs and services to residents of the waterfront catchment area. As a City of Toronto AOCC (Association of Community Centres) agency, Waterfront Neighbourhood Centre operates differently than a Parks & Recreation facility. It is unique, as the 8 community member Board of Management is appointed by the City of Toronto – City Council to manage this multi-service community centre in accordance with the needs and direction of the local community. Board Committees further support the work of WNC.

The Board of Management is involved in implementing a variety of new program and fundraising initiatives including a building & strategic visioning process in light of the rapid population growth in our neighbourhood and economic constraints facing the City of Toronto, who is WNC's major funder.

To assist with the implementation of present and future initiatives, Waterfront Neighbourhood Centre is looking *first* to WNC's existing volunteer membership to become further engaged with WNC's governance work either as a WNC Committee member and/or possible Board Member.

Board Committees include the following: Finance, Program, Communication; Fundraising & Special Events as well as other Special Project Sub-Committees which are currently underway; Parent & Youth Advisory; Volunteer Programs; Rental & Program Access, to name a few. WNC is seeking to add dynamic individuals to the Board and Committees for a four year term with the following knowledge, transferable skills and expertise:

- Experience in one or more areas of Board governance and its committee work in the following areas: Human Resources; Planning & Organizational Development; Labour Relations; Technology & IT skills, Senior level Business Management and/or Finance Experience (corporate or non-profit); Event Planning & Fundraising; and Communications & Social Media.
- Related volunteer experience directly with WNC over the past year and/or successful alternative experience on similar non-profit boards, agencies, committees, associations and/or other community groups.
- Personal commitment to the vision, mission, program actions strategy and ongoing business of WNC.
- Have personal time available to contribute as an active member and volunteer worker on committees, task groups, fundraising, special events and other activities of the Board.
- Must be a member in good standing with WNC and a resident of the City of Toronto, and over 18 years of age.
- The following personal attributes are an asset: Team Player, Positive Attitude, Problem Solver, Creative Thinker, willing to share personal network/contacts, Active Contributor and Promoter of WNC.
